3. The second lecture for the Sandon Local History Society will be about Mediaeval Liverpool. It will be given by J.J. Bagley in the Music Room on Thursday, 19th February. An audience of seventy-five attended the first lecture in January.
4. Towards the end of February the Literary and Dramatic Group will stage an entertainment "Bad Verse and Worse Prose". Details will be posted on the notice boards.
